### **Committee Reports**

#### **Communications Committee (Chris Stergio):**

- Website is up-to-date including:
  - o SBC ELT News through Sep 2017
  - List of ELT Officers and Members
  - Calendar through Dec 2017
- Deleted undeliverable addresses in JSC SBC distribution list (currently 288 SBC members)
- Summarized counts for SBC Event held in Aug 2017:
  - o 179 registrations
  - o 139 event attendance (10 walk-ins)
  - 40% of attendees found out about the event through a SBC member (20% from EventBrite invitation, 18.5% from a colleague)
  - o 161 surveys distributed, 73 responses

### Social Committee (Al Turner and Joy Lacy):

- Joy and Al have identified several potential venues for January Social Mixer (Studio 80, Nobi Public House, the Bold House, Preamble Lounge & Craft House)
- Last year was at Momalone's Restaurant (venue was too small)
- Attendance last year was over 100; expect more this year since Primes are being invited

#### Ric's Clean Slate (NASA JSC)

- 2017 center level winners are listed on the OSBP website
  - Large business Hensel Phelps
  - Small business prime Made in Space
  - o Small business contractor San Diego Composites
- JSC received a Grade B on their scorecard (three points short for Grade A); Exceeded 2 of 5 business goals; Need more businesses to self-certify as SDB
- JSC considering increasing Service Disabled and HUB Zone goals
- JSC Initiative #1 (Small Business Technical Coordinators (SBTCs)):
  - Continuing to assess needs of JSC organizations
  - Engineering SBTC input resulted in successful Light Manufacturing Event
  - Looking at having a Light Manufacturing II Event to find vendors for:
    - Wire harnesses for satellites and spacecraft
    - Robotics
    - Applied IT (hardware developers that also perform software engineering)
- JSC Initiative #2 (HBCU Goals):
  - Large Primes are having trouble meeting HBCU goals
  - o Ric is planning to put together a "how to" and "lessons learned" package, which can then be presented at a conference for large businesses and universities so that all can learn how to manage HBCUs in procurements

## **New Business**

- Fernando presented feedback from SpaceCom:
  - The event was successful
  - Robert Lightfoot and Ellen Ochoa attended
  - o Attendance increased from last year; Fernando will receive the final count at a later date
  - Having more food helped keep attendance up people did not have to leave for lunch so stayed longer)
  - Organizers already have everything booked for next year
- Denise asked Ric to set up a meeting between SBC and Prime Council; Focus is our joint initiatives and feasibility of determining prime marketing opportunities so that SBC can disseminate the information to SB community
